UPDATED BULLYING PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION POLICY

Our [Bullying Prevention and Intervention Policy](#) has recently been updated to reflect the latest Victorian Government guidance. The policy reinforces our commitment to preventing bullying through the explicit teaching of respectful relationships, early intervention and clear processes for responding to bullying when it occurs.

It is important to remember that bullying is different from everyday conflict or friendship disagreements. While conflict is a normal part of learning and growing, bullying involves repeated behaviour that causes harm and requires a different response. We value the important partnership between home and school in supporting student wellbeing. If you have concerns about your child's wellbeing or believe they may be experiencing bullying, please contact your child's classroom teacher or a member of the leadership team. The updated policy is available on our school website, and we encourage families to take a few moments to read it as we continue working together to ensure our school remains a place where every student is **Kind, Curious and Brave**.
