2024 FOUNDATION (PREP) ENROLMENTS

The Department of Education (DE) has released a new state-wide Foundation (Prep) enrolment timeline.

The timeline advises families when and how to enrol their child into Foundation (Prep) at a Victorian government primary school, including Quarry Hill Primary School.

The new timeline will apply for children starting Foundation (Prep) in 2024. All government primary schools will follow the new timeline in 2023 to support Foundation (Prep) enrolments for the 2024 school year.

You can find information and resources about the new timeline, including factsheets, at: <u>Enrolling in Foundation</u> (<u>Prep</u>). You can also download the 'Foundation (Prep) Enrolment Information Pack for Parents/Carers for the 2024 school year' from our webpage.

You can apply to enrol your child in Foundation (Prep) 2024 at Quarry Hill Primary School as of now.

What you need to do:

- 1. Contact our school on 5443537 to book a place on one of our scheduled school tours or to learn more about our school and the enrolment application process.
- 2. Download the Foundation (Prep) enrolment information pack from Enrolling in Foundation (Prep)
- 3. Submit an enrolment application for Foundation (Prep) by Friday 28 July 2023 (earlier would be preferred)
- 4. You will be notified of the outcome of your application by Friday 11 August 2023. If you receive an offer of placement, you should contact our school to accept the offer by Friday 25 August 2023
- 5. Take part in enrolment information and transition sessions during Term 4, 2023
- 6. Your child will start their first full day of Prep at QHPS on **Friday 2 February 2024**. (Testing will occur on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Prep teachers will organise the appointments.)

Enrolment applications submitted after 28 July 2023 will be processed by our school as they are received, in accordance with the department's Placement Policy.

Our School Zone

Our school zone is available on <u>findmyschool.vic.gov.au</u> which hosts the most up-to-date information on school zones in Victoria.

Students residing within our school zone are guaranteed a place at our school, which is determined on the basis of your permanent residential address.

In the first instance, Quarry Hill Primary School draws its enrolments from our 'designated neighbourhood zone'. This zone has been devised, in consultation with our Regional Office, taking into consideration the location of other local primary schools.

Where there is insufficient accommodation at our school for all students who seek entry, students are enrolled in the following priority order:

- Students for whom our school is the designated neighbourhood government school.
- Students with a sibling at the same permanent residence who are attending our school at the same time.
- All the students in order of closeness of their permanent residence to the 'designated neighbourhood zone' boundary.

Our school manages enrolments using the <u>Placement Policy</u> to ensure that students have access to their designated neighbourhood school and may enrol at another school, if there are available places.

If you have a child starting next year, we would appreciate them being enrolled as soon as possible please. (Preferably before the nominated 28 July if possible.) If you know that you will not be here at Quarry Hill Primary School next year, please let us know. This enables us to have a better idea about the number of Prep children we can enrol and about the grade levels where there may be places available for other students.

GYM PROGRAM PREP - GRADE 4 ONLY

Our Gymnastics program starts Tuesday May 30^{th} . It will take place at Jets Gym, Golden Square for Grade Prep -4 and the cost will be \$33.00. The lessons will be of 60 minutes duration and will be conducted by qualified Gymnastics instructors. Children are required to wear loose fitting clothing without zips and extra buttons. School polo shirts, shorts and tracksuit pants are suitable.

SCHOLASTIC BOOK CLUB

The LOOP facility eliminates the need to put your credit card number on the order form and/or hand over cash. For paper copy book orders please include your child's name and classroom room number and/or teacher on the top of the form and return to office with correct payment by due date. Thanks, Amanda.

DROP OFF AND COLLECTION ALONG PEEL STREET

It has come to our attention that the designated accessible carpark zones are being used by others during the more congested drop off and pick up times. We have a number of families in our school who require easy access to these parks. Only cars that have an Accessible Parking Permit clearly displayed on their windscreen are to use these parks please.

An Accessible Parking Permit:

- Can only be displayed when the vehicle's transporting the individual who the permit was issued to
- Must be clearly displayed so that the permit number and expiry date are visible from outside the vehicle.

Parents and carers waiting to turn into the time bound car parks along Peel Street are also reminded that it is illegal to remain stationary on the school crossing.

The City of Greater Bendigo randomly checks school zones and has been known to issue fines. We thank you for your help with this.

CYBER SAFETY



New resources to support First Nations people be deadly online

Latest eSafety research shows that young Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people are turning to technology for cultural expression and engagement. They are almost twice as likely as young people in Australia overall to post original video or music online, and more than twice as likely to post their own story or blog. Unfortunately, they are also almost three times more likely to experience hate speech. New resources to encourage better experiences for communities and support First Nations people navigate the online world safely are now available. These include stories from mob and new video and audio content in multiple First Nations languages.

Express learning: Watch bite size videos on ways to keep your family safe online


eSafety's Express learning series provides parents and carers with practical tips and advice on common online safety concerns. The videos are 5 to 10 minutes long and cover four important topics, including:
