ICAS 2023

Dear Parents and Carers

We are delighted to inform you that Quarry Hill Primary School will again facilitate student participation in the ICAS competition this year for students in Year 3 to Year 6.

What is ICAS?

ICAS is an online academic competition that is designed to assess students' higher order thinking and problem-solving skills across a range of curriculum areas. This year we will participate in English, Mathematics and Science.

Each assessment celebrates students' accomplishments by providing opportunities for recognition and development. Every student who participates will receive a printed certificate and an online results report. Top performers will be eligible for medals.

How to participate in ICAS

If you wish for your child to participate in ICAS this year, please:

- 2. read the terms and conditions here: (icasassessments.com/wp-content/uploads/2022/10/2023-ICAS-Assessments-Parents-PPS-TsCs final.pdf)
- 2. go to Parent Portal to purchase tests here: (shop.icasassessments.com/pages/pps)
- enter our school's access code LME199 3.
- 4. enter your child's details, select the tests you would like to purchase, then proceed to payment. The closing date for the Parent Portal Payment system is Monday July31st.

Please note that the ICAS tests shown for selection are at the school's discretion.

After payment is made via the Parent Payment System, you will receive an order confirmation email, please keep this for your records.

ICAS Results and Certificates

We will notify you of the date(s) that we run ICAS at the school and when your child's ICAS results are ready. Once we have received your child's ICAS certificate, we will send it home with your child. The back of the certificate shows ICAS results and the login details, "TAP ID and Pin", that you and your child need to enter the Results Portal orti.icasassessments.com/ortiStudent




