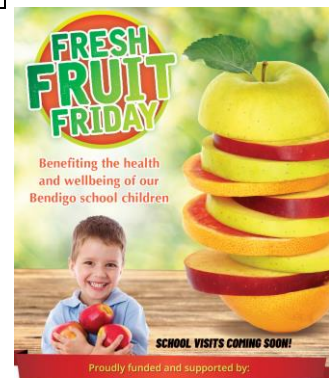
#### CURRICULUM DAY
