Topics covered are:

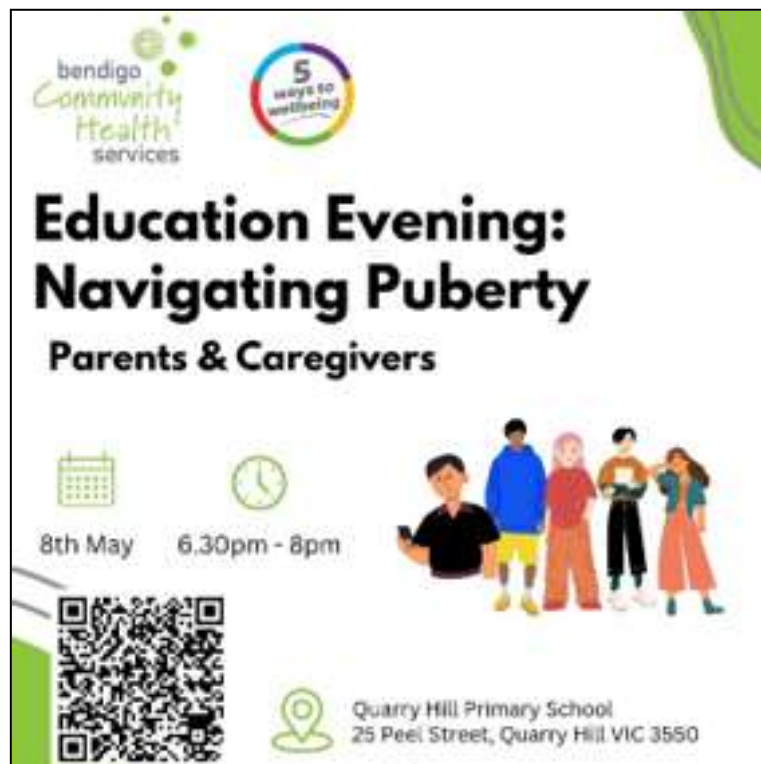
- LGBTIQ+ information
