- Information about Camp Australia, its services and cost, can be found in the Information Booklet.

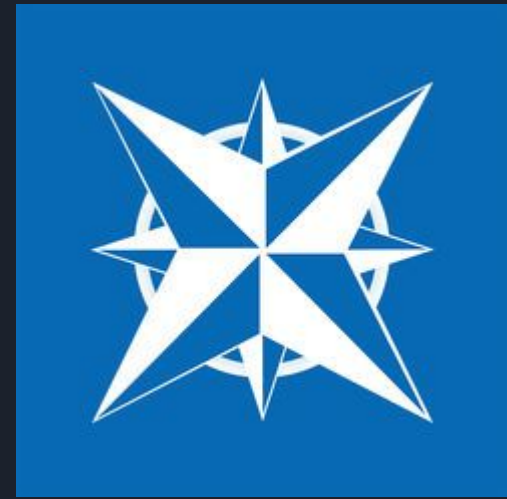
